In 2022, through the efforts of the Board of Trustees and staff, the Foundation embraced and expanded its core missions of forward-looking research and academic outreach. With generous financial support from our industry audience, the Foundation exceeded its annual financial sustainability goals, marking one of many important milestones of the year.

Over the past year, the Foundation:

- Produced and published a new edition of the Industry Horizon Report (market sizing study), estimating the size of the equipment finance industry at \$1.16 trillion
- Awarded five \$5,000 scholarships to deserving students, up from three awards the previous year
- Facilitated discussions with Industry Future Council (IFC) volunteers and published a report focused on workforce trends of the future
- Broke records with our 5th Annual Day of Giving, with 141 gifts totaling \$93,150
- Supported volunteers in the delivery of 14 Guest Lectures at colleges and universities across the country
- Rebranded the 1989 Society and welcomed 12 new members, formalizing the Foundation's legacy giving program




